

KEARNY HIGH SCHOOL



KEARNY High School's modern building was completed during the summer of 1923, in time for classes in the fall. Incorporated in it was all of the most modern educational equipment, and when built it was a model for other communities to copy. The building has a large swimming pool, two well equipped gymnasiums and an auditorium seating 1,200 people and containing a large pipe organ and a stage that is supplied with modern devices for use in dramatic productions. The building is

equipped with excellent classroom facilities, offices and workshops. Imposing in its architecture, the structure is a landmark easily distinguishable across the Meadows. When the school was built, its size was questioned, some maintaining that it was too large for the number who would attend. The class of 1924, the first to graduate, comprised only a few over one hundred and the total enrollment was about nine hundred. Registration for 1932-1933 was 1,946. This is far more than the school can accommodate in one session.
