### DEDICATION TO BILL McEWAN

When Mr. William McEwan passed away in December of 1961, The Presbyterian Boys' Club lost a great friend and director. For a long time Mr. McEwan had been one of the most active men in supporting the club. In our scouting program, he had served as cubmaster and assistant scoutmaster. A P.R.C. director of long standing, he served as chairman of the Board of Directors for two years. At the time of his death he was chairman of the Gold Cross Committee. December 1961.

Mr. McEwan's activities did not stop at the P.R.C. He was active in church and veterans' affairs, a willing volunteer on many charity drives, and a team manager in the Pony and Little Leagues.

Other activities included serving as counselor at Kamp Kiamesha, and working in the Joseph Frobisher Post #99 of the American Legion.
