

# Lau, Gillespie To Speak At Graduation Tonight

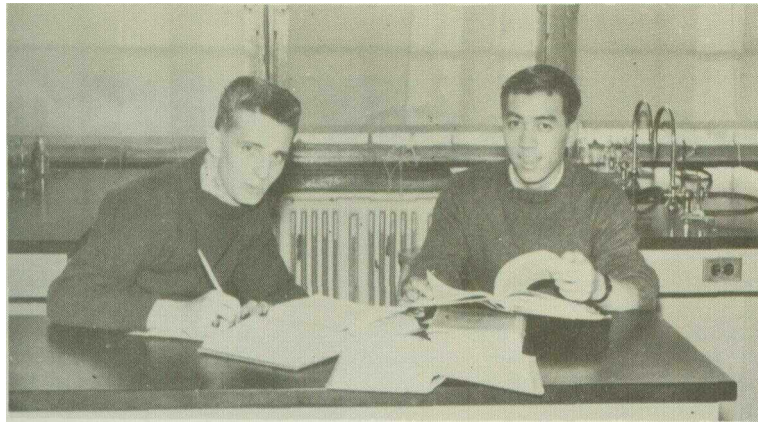
