Harrison Veteran of Pacific Fighting Is Commissioned

Lt. Louis J. Sode, 24, son of Mrs. Mable Sode of 507 Harrison avenue, Harrison, a veteran of Pearl Harbor and the South Pacific island fighting, has received his pilot wings in the AAF at Marfa Army Air Base, Texas. He completed the course Tuesday.

Lt. Sode, native of Harrison, enlisted June 5, 1941, in the infantry. He was later transferred to the Signal Corps and was sent to Ordnance Officer Candidates' School

Aberdeen, Md. He was commissioned in September, 1943. He married Miss Irene Hughes of Harrison who now lives with his mother.

The lieutenant served with the Army at Guadalcanal, the Christmas Islands, New Guinea and the Fiji islands. He returned to this country about a year ago and became an aviation cadet last September at Marfa Army Air Base. He is expected home on leave.
